

Definition of HNS


HNS implies all actions undertaken in the preparedness phase and the disaster response management by a Participating State, receiving or sending assistance, or the Commission, in order to remove as much as possible any foreseeable obstacle to international assistance to ensure that disaster response operations proceed smoothly.

It also includes the support that the Participating States can provide to facilitate international assistance transiting through their territory by land, sea, or air.

EU Host Nation Support Guidelines

The project and the tabletop exercises are based on the Commission staff working document:

TTX MD: Exercise Management

The exercise will be headed by the Exercise Director and the Project Director.

The **Exercise Logistics, Technic, Support, and Media** supports the Exercise Management is responsible for the Exercise Logistics such as transportation, venue, meals, accommodation, the holistic venue organisation, and administrative support. It supports the handling of VIP visits, supports the observers and is responsible for the safety and security of all participants and staff.

The **Exercise Control (EXCON)** in this Table-Top Exercise will be headed by the Chief Exercise Controller, who has the overall responsibility for the conduct of the exercise and directs for this task the EXCON Cell and its subordinates. He is directly supported in his work by the inject Cell and the VR team, as well as the Main Evaluator, Main Trainer, and Logistics & Support Team.

The EXCON is overseeing the implementation of the exercise, the injects, the role-player and the VR integration:

- The **Exercise Situation Cell** consists of the virtual ERCC, the training vOSOCC, directs the virtual modules and oversees the injects and role-player and ensures smooth cooperation between both. It supports EXCON and the main trainer in keeping an overview of the Situation development and keeps abreast of the real-time situation development.
- The **Inject Cell** guarantees the timely flow of injects with the right kind of media and/or channel used. It cooperates strongly with the Main Trainer and EXCON to identify the needed exact timings.
- The **Role Player Cell** will brief the role-players used to deliver (planned) injects or to contribute ad-hoc to provide the best learning environment for the participants. Observers will also be invited to support in role-playing.

The **Main Trainer** will lead the group of trainers, take the training-related decision directly or in coordination with EXCON, and strongly interacts with the Exercise Situation Cell as well as Quality Management & Evaluation team

In support of the Main Trainer, the UCPT Trainer, the Response Teams Trainer and the HNS Trainer will directly support their cells as trainers and mentors to guarantee a strong learning effect, they act as a direct connection to the EXCON and solve exercise-related questions. They will also take responsibility for the well-being and comfort of every participant in their cell.

The **Quality Management & Evaluation Team** is guaranteeing high quality in the implementation of the exercise, provides feedback on possible needed adjustments to other cells and is also responsible for the evaluation process of the contractor and the participants.

TTX MD: Exercise Scenario



A severe earthquake with a magnitude of 8 Degrees on the Richter scale struck the central region, specifically south of Chişinău, on Tuesday evening 21st of February 2023 at (23:00).

The earthquake epicentre was in the Eastern area, where the region of Căinari, in Căuşeni District is the most affected area, the population in the affected area is about (80,000) people. Many buildings in the affected area villages of Căinari were collapsed and damaged, which causes many injuries and deaths, and many were trapped under the rubble.

The number of injuries, according to the initial statistic, reached about (3,000), in addition to the deaths, which were estimated at (hundreds) so far, many homeless people without homes, where their number is estimated at (10,000) people, including a high number of refugees, located at this district.

Severe damage and collapses in XXXXX Factory for Insecticides and Agricultural Fertilizers resulted in a leakage of toxic chemicals which were mixed with the flood waters as (ammonium phosphate), which forms a toxic chemical cloud. The infrastructure in the affected area (roads, bridges, electrical power production facilities, communications, and sewage systems) is badly destroyed, countrywide there are power failures due to the interrupted electrical grid.

International Assistance

The “State of Emergency” was stated. Based on what was mentioned in the scenario and based on handling these events has exceeded the capabilities of the state, and after the issuance of the political decision to request various types of international assistance, the need of requesting the following international humanitarian assistance has been identified:

- International urban search and rescue teams (USAR) due to the presence of many damaged and destroyed buildings, fully and partially, with many trapped under the rubble
- Field hospitals, Emergency Medical Teams (EMT), various medical supplies and medications, due to a partially damaged hospital in the affected area, as the number of injuries is very high (about 5,000 injuries)
- In-kind assistance (shelters, beds for patients, blankets, generators ... etc.)
- Specialized Chemical Decontamination teams to disinfect people and areas contaminated with chemicals
- Drinking water purification units, due to the pollution in drinking water as a result of its sources contamination with chemicals and leaking sewage water

TTX MD: Timeframe and Time-Jumps

The exercise should cover all phases of the mission cycle. Therefore, time jumps will be implemented to cover all the major phases of the simulated mission (full deployment cycle) from the Request for Assistance at ERCC to the handover phase at the end of the exercise.

There will be lunch breaks, after lunch breaks and at the start of the second-day briefings are held, to explain the new situation of the relevant exercise day.

The role of participants during the TTX

During the exercise, the players perform their roles as they would in an actual deployment. In an exercise like this, it is simply unavoidable that there will be some artificialities or things that proceed differently with the real deployment. This is brought to a minimum, and players are asked to cope with this constructively.

- **It is important that players do not make up for their incidents,**
- **The scenario remains as it is presented,**
- **It is the best exercise when everyone reacts the way they would in reality.**

Exercise Time

The time in the exercise is the actual time, both regarding the timing as well as in terms of the speed at which everything unfolds. Everything is running in real-time.

This means that in this exercise all reports, press releases and requests and commands to other coordinating and executive bodies need to be worked out completely unless you are explicitly told to do otherwise.

TTX MD: Exercise Design

Exercise Framework:


Cooperation between all civil protection actors involved in emergency management is vital so that any international assistance can be integrated quickly and effectively within the local emergency response mechanisms.

The EU HNS guidelines were adopted in January 2012 and built on existing international recommendations and practices. They specifically target the facilitation of assistance operations under the UCPM improving solidarity amongst the participating states.

Third countries that are likely to request and receive assistance in case of need under this framework are also encouraged to consider these guidelines.

The Host National Support Guideline aims at assisting and supporting the affected state to receive international assistance most effectively and efficiently, whether in the preparedness or disaster response phases.

The ultimate objective of HNS is to remove as much as possible many foreseeable obstacles to international assistance. This ensures that disaster response operations proceed smoothly.



Exercise Objective:

The objective is to design, plan, conduct and self-evaluate host national support tabletop exercises for key actors of the UCPM response, including the ERCC and its main interlocutors at European, national, and international levels.

The ultimate scope will be to increase the exchange of procedures and best practices regarding hosting and coordination of the incoming international assistance in a non-EU-affected country, increase knowledge of the EU Host Nation Support Guidelines, and identify possible areas for improvement in the institutional and operational emergency response framework.


Exercise Scenario:

The main exercise scenario is a severe earthquake with cascading effects, followed by flooding due to a broken dam in that region.

Several UCPM partners, UN OCHA, WHO, IFRC and national and international NGOs are assisting. The exercise scenario will be designed so that the following actions are covered:

- HNS framework in the host country
- Multi-sector dimension
- A scenario in a complex environment
- The implication of other relevant authorities in the host country

TTX MD: Exercise Setup



Trainer/Mentors

During the exercise, there will be the trainers present with the teams. The trainers will mentor the teams and provide them with feedback on their performance.

Otherwise, they will be the eyes and ears of the exercise control.


Observers:

EU HNS TTX has no observer program. Observers from the implementing partners are non-playing participants and are present to observe and learn from the TTX. This is designed to allow them to understand the roles and tasks of the different actors involved.

Part of the observer participation is also that they provide feedback on the setup and organisation of the exercises.

Observers can participate in the exercise as role players, simulating e.g., international media, local governors, or any other but always based on a clear script.

TTX MD: Evaluation



During and after the exercises two types of evaluations will be carried out:

Evaluation from the contractor

With its scientific partner from the University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science, and Technology of Târgu Mureș the design, planning and conduct of the TTX will be evaluated on behalf of the European Commission.

Evaluation from participants

During and after each exercise the exercise management will evaluate the quality of the exercise. During the exercise it is important to keep a sharp notice of the progress of each exercise phase and if the participants are still able to reach their goals.

The internal evaluation is done in the following manners. During the exercise, input is gathered by the trainers. After the exercise input is gathered via evaluation forms given to participants, hot-washes and debriefings with participants coordinated by the trainers and finally a lessons-learned meeting with the total exercise management.

constructive hot-wash-up and feedback sessions

A constructive hot-wash-up and feedback sessions will be provided for all participants on day three of the TTX. This is to get feedback from the participants and to record lessons identified from the exercise.


The purpose of evaluating the exercises is to identify possible improvements for the next exercises and to check if the exercise met the expectations of the participants.
